<u>Mirrors of Truth:</u> We will meet again on November 15th at 7pm. Our discussion will follow up the excellent presentation on Roger Penrose's newest work <u>Fashion</u>, <u>Faith</u>, <u>and Fantasy in the New Physics of the Universe</u>, with some patristic reflections on the issues raised in the book.

Verses on thanksgiving in the New Testament compiled and published by Fr. John Jillions on the O.C.A. website

- 1. Matthew 11:25 At that time Jesus declared, "I thank thee, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to babes...
- 2. <u>Matthew 15:36</u> he took the seven loaves and the fish, and **having given thanks** he broke them and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds.
- 3. Matthew 26:27 And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you...
- 4. <u>Luke 17:16</u> and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, **giving him thanks**. Now he was a Samaritan.
- 5. <u>Luke 22:17</u> And he took a cup, and **when he had given thanks** he said, "Take this, and divide it among yourselves;
- 6. <u>Luke 22:19</u> And he took bread, and **when he had given thanks** he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
- 7. Romans 1:8 First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed in all the world.
- 8. <u>1 Corinthians 1:4</u> I give thanks to God always for you because of the grace of God which was given you in Christ Jesus...
- 9. <u>1 Corinthians 10:30</u> If I partake with thankfulness, why am I denounced because of that for which I give thanks?
- 10. <u>1 Corinthians 11:24</u> and **when he had given thanks**, he broke it, and said, "This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
- 11. <u>1 Corinthians 14:16</u> Otherwise, if you bless with the spirit, how can any one in the position of an outsider say the "Amen" **to your thanksgiving** when he does not know what you are saying?
- 12. <u>1 Corinthians 15:57</u> **But thanks be to God**, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 13. <u>2 Corinthians 1:11</u> You also must help us by prayer, so that many will **give thanks** on our behalf for the blessing granted us in answer to many prayers.
- 14. <u>2 Corinthians 2:14</u> But **thanks be to God**, who in Christ always leads us in triumph, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.
- 15. <u>2 Corinthians 4:15</u> For it is all for your sake, so that as grace extends to more and more people it may **increase thanksgiving**, to the glory of God.
- 16. <u>2 Corinthians 9:11</u> You will be enriched in every way for great generosity, which through us will **produce thanksgiving to God**;
- 17. <u>2 Corinthians 9:12</u> for the rendering of this service not only supplies the wants of the saints but also overflows in **many thanksgivings to God**.
