Verses on thanksgiving in the New Testament compiled and published by Fr. John Jillions on the O.C.A. website

1. Matthew 11:25 At that time Jesus declared, "I **thank thee**, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that

- thou hast hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to babes...
2. Matthew 15:36 he took the seven loaves and the fish, and **having given thanks** he broke them and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds.
  3. Matthew 26:27 And he took a cup, and **when he had given thanks** he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you..."
  4. Luke 17:16 and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, **giving him thanks**. Now he was a Samaritan.
  5. Luke 22:17 And he took a cup, and **when he had given thanks** he said, "Take this, and divide it among yourselves;
  6. Luke 22:19 And he took bread, and **when he had given thanks** he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
  7. Romans 1:8 First, **I thank my God through Jesus Christ** for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed in all the world.
  8. 1 Corinthians 1:4 **I give thanks to God** always for you because of the grace of God which was given you in Christ Jesus...
  9. 1 Corinthians 10:30 **If I partake with thankfulness**, why am I denounced because of that **for which I give thanks?**
  10. 1 Corinthians 11:24 and **when he had given thanks**, he broke it, and said, "This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
  11. 1 Corinthians 14:16 Otherwise, if you bless with the spirit, how can any one in the position of an outsider say the "Amen" **to your thanksgiving** when he does not know what you are saying?
  12. 1 Corinthians 15:57 **But thanks be to God**, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
  13. 2 Corinthians 1:11 You also must help us by prayer, so that many will **give thanks** on our behalf for the blessing granted us in answer to many prayers.
  14. 2 Corinthians 2:14 But **thanks be to God**, who in Christ always leads us in triumph, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.
  15. 2 Corinthians 4:15 For it is all for your sake, so that as grace extends to more and more people it may **increase thanksgiving**, to the glory of God.
  16. 2 Corinthians 9:11 You will be enriched in every way for great generosity, which through us will **produce thanksgiving to God**;
  17. 2 Corinthians 9:12 for the rendering of this service not only supplies the wants of the saints but also overflows in **many thanksgivings to God**.
  18. 2 Corinthians 9:15 Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift!
  19. Ephesians 1:16 **I do not cease to give thanks** for you, remembering you in my prayers,
  20. Ephesians 5:4 Let there be no filthiness, nor silly talk, nor levity, which are not fitting; **but instead let there be thanksgiving**.
  21. Ephesians 5:20 always **and for everything give thanks** in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God the Father.
  22. Philippians 4:6 Have no anxiety about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication **with thanksgiving** let your requests be made known to God.
  23. Colossians 1:3 **We always thank God**, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you...
  24. Colossians 1:12 **give thanks to the Father**, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.
  25. Colossians 2:7 rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, **abounding in thanksgiving**.
  26. Colossians 3:17 And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, **giving thanks to God the Father through him**.
  27. Colossians 4:2 Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it **with thanksgiving**;
  28. 1 Thessalonians 1:2 **We give thanks to God** always for you all, constantly mentioning you in our prayers...
  29. 1 Thessalonians 3:9 **For what thanksgiving can we render to God** for you, for all the joy which we feel for your sake before our God...
  30. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 **give thanks in all circumstances**; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
  31. 2 Thessalonians 1:3 **We are bound to give thanks to God** always for you, brethren, as is fitting, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing.
  32. 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But **we are bound to give thanks to God** always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God chose you from the beginning to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth.
  33. 1 Timothy 2:1 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, **and thanksgivings** be made for all men...
  34. 1 Timothy 4:4 For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is **received with thanksgiving**...
  35. 2 Timothy 1:3 **I thank God** whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.
