Please do not make arrangements for receptions without speaking with the Rector first.

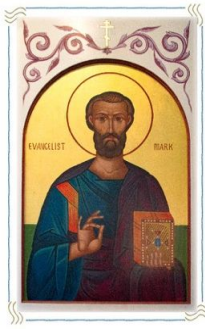
Weekly Schedule of Services and Events:

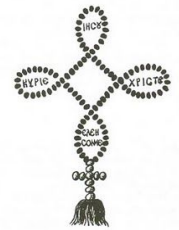
