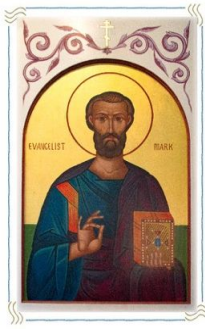
**Epistle:** Gal. 2:16-20; 2 Corinthians 4: 6-15
