**Evening Service**

**At “Lord, I call...,” 3 stikhera, in Tone 1: *Special melody: “Joy of the ranks of heaven...”***

While dwelling here on earth, O blessèd Artemon, /

Therefore thou art ever hailed as the heavenly man ///

As thou presented thyself before the immaterial brightness; /  
And being illumined by divine radiance /  
Thou dost dispel the darkness of the passions by thy prayers, ///  
Ever enlightening our souls, O wise one.

**O** holy hieromartyr /  
Never cease to pray for us /  
Who with faith celebrate thy memory /  
And praise the wondrous feats of thy martyrdom; /  
The we be preserved from tribulation *and* sorrow /  
And from every future corruption, ///  
O martyr Artemon, the preacher of God.

**Glory... now and ever..., Theotokion, in Tone 1:**

**W**allowing in the filth of corruption I now lie exhausted /  
Yet I hasten to thy tranquil haven, O pure Virgin, /  
Deliver me from the tempest and from many temptations /  
That I may ever praise thy grace and mercy ///  
O Ever-virgin Mother, Theotokos.

**S**tanding before the Cross of thy Son and God, /  
And beholding His long-suffering,  
O pure Mother, thou didst cry out weeping: /  
Woe is me, O my Child most sweet! /  
What are these things which Thou dost suffer unjustly, ///  
O Word of God, that Thou mightest save mankind?
