Commemoration of the Holy Apostles and Deacons of the Seventy: Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, and Parmenas.

And the Appearance of the Smolensk (Hodegitria) Icon of our Lady, the Mother of God, whose service is provided separately.

Evening Service

At “Lord, I call...,” 3 stikhera, in Tone 1: *Special melody: “The heavenly ranks...”*

By divine election you were chosen to serve the requests of the saints, /
Being filled with divine wisdom, enlightenment, and grace; /
Now you abide in the heavens ///
Ceaselessly rejoicing with the angels.

Being revealed by the grace of the Spirit /
To be bright candles to the world, /
You shone brightly with the radiance of understanding /
Scattering the fog of evil ///
And now you abide with the never-setting light, O Apostles.

Let us praise the most-sacred Nicanor and Prochorus /
And together with them let us honor Timon and Parmenas, /
For they fulfilled the commandments of the Word /
And gave their riches away to the poor ///
And are the most fervent intercessors before our God.

Glory... now and ever..., Theotokion, in the Same Tone:

I am laid low and lie in the filth of my vices, /
Yet I crawl to thy peaceful refuge, O Virgin! /
Deliver me from the storms of passion and from every temptation /
That I may ever sing ///
The praises of thy grace, O Birthgiver of God and Ever-virgin Mother

Or the Stavrotheotokion:

When she beheld the Lamb lifted up upon the Cross, /
The most pure Virgin cried out lamenting: /
O my Sweet Child /
What is this new and all-glorious wonder? /
How is it that Thou Who holdest all things in the hollow of Thy hand, ///
Art nailed to the Tree in the flesh?

Or Dogmatic Theotokion if a resurrection service.

The General Troparion to the Apostles, in Tone 3:

O Holy Apostles, /
Intercede with our merciful God, /
That He may grant to our souls ///
The forgiveness of our sins.
